

## INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS ACT, 1976

**Report by the Registrar of Trade Unions  
1993 - 1994**

The Minister for Education and Human Resources

Sir,

1. I have to submit the Annual Report in accordance with the provision of Section 14(1) of the Industrial Relations Act, 1976, for the period 1st July, 1993, to 30th June, 1994.

2. At the beginning of the period under review there were 57 organisations on the register, made up of 35 Trade Unions and 22 Employers' Associations.

3. The Union of Legal Graduates of Mid-Med Bank, the Paceville and Nearby Restaurants and Places of Entertainment Association, the Goldsmith and Silversmith Association, the Textile Services (Laundries) Association and the St. Edward's College Teachers' Union were registered during this period.

4. The membership strength of Trade Unions and Employers' Associations as compared with those of my previous report are as follows:—

5. No routine inspections were carried out during the period under review.

6. Neither Trade Unions nor Employers' Associations were cancelled or dissolved during the period under review.

7. The returns show an overall increase of 5,477 in membership from last year.

8. The organisations which failed to render complete returns by law are the Union of Government Medical Doctors; the Association of Artists for Radio, Television, Stage and Screen; the Airmalta Executive Union; the Port Contractors Workers Union; the Oil Tanking Operators Union; the Mill Owners Association; the Assoċjazzjoni tal-Bdiewa; the Association of Private Hire Bus Owners; the Għaqda tad-Dulċiera; the Public Cleaners Association; the Association of Tractor and Trailer Operators/Owners; the Gozo Bus Owners Association, and the Għaqda tal-Furnara u Bejjiegħa tal-Hobż.
