INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS ACT, 1976

Report by Registrar of Trade Unions 1983 — 1984

The Minister of Labour
and Social Services

Sir

I have to submit the annual report in accordance with the provisions of Section 14 (1) of the Industrial Relations Act 1976 for the period 1st July, 1983 to 30th June, 1984.

2. At the beginning of the period there were 34 organisations on the register, made up of 14 trade unions and 20 employers' associations.

3. Three employers' associations were registered during this period. These were the Għaqda Bdiewa Progressivi (No. 215) with 322 members, Public Cleansers Association (No. 216) with 20 members and the Association of Estate Agents (No. 217) with 15 members. Another employers' association, the Association of Self-Catering Accommodation (ASCA) and a trade union, the Union of Flight Attendants were registered after 30th June, 1984, and will therefore feature in next year's report.

4. During the same period there were three employers' associations, and one trade union can-

celled from the register after failing to render returns under para. 12 of the Industrial Relations Act.

These were The Mechanized Quarry Owners (No. 87), The Association of Hard Stone Quarry Owners (No. 129), The Assocjazzjoni tal-Mini Buses Kiri (No. 201) and the Union of Executive and Managerial Employees (No. 210).

5. Therefore at the end of the period under review there were 33 organisations on the register. These were made up of 14 trade unions and 19 employers' associations.

6. The membership strength of Trade Unions and Employers' Associations as compared with those of my previous report are as follows:

7. Routine inspections were carried out of the records of The Movement of United Teachers, The Movement of United Bank Employees and the GRTU — Association of General Retailers and Traders, with their records being found in order. A similar inspection was made of the records of the Association of Self-Employed and Employers. In this case as the required records were not produced when asked for, a notice of cancellation was issued. However the request was complied with before the notice of cancellation lapsed.

8. The only organisations which failed to render complete returns as required by law were the Kamra ta' l-Ispizjara — Trade Union (No. 189) and the Yacht Traders Association (No. 193), although the first one had given its membership strength. Both organisations were issued with a Notice of

Cancellation which would take effect in two months' time if there is still no compliance by then.

9. Returns show an overall decrease of 1.804 in membership from last year.

10. The Appendix which follows contains details of trade unions and employers' associations on the Register on 30th June, 1984.
